Code of Conduct for the Teaching Staff



- + The members of the teaching staff should be models of decency in their dress and demeanor culture and academic leadership. They should be impartial in dealing with any student problems.
- + Lecturer should avoid wearing gaudy looking clothes likely to arouse the curiosity, resentment or amusement of students, which will distract their attention towards the teaching.
- + He/she should be punctual to the college and enter the classroom at the prescribed time and utilize the full time allotted for teaching. He/she should not leave the class before prescribed time is over.
- + He/she should go to the class thoroughly prepared and maintain all academic records, update knowledge and acquaintance with the latest trends in the subject.

- ✚ *The lecturers should utilize their leisure time for preparation of class work or to update their knowledge in the subject.*
- ✚ *Except giving synopsis of the lecture they should avoid dictating detailed notes in the class room.*
- ✚ *He/she must be present during the working hours of the college and if required he/she should also be present in the college until the work assigned is completed.*
- ✚ *He/she should not smoke, chew pan during the class hours and should not indulge in any act of indiscipline.*
- ✚ *He/she should always try to command the respect of the student community.*
- ✚ *The lecturer should be absent with the prior permission of the Principal and prior intimation to lecturer in charge of the department, without which the alternate arrangement for running the classes is not possible.*





- + *The lecturer should not engage private tuitions and should not take up any assignments part time or full time in any other organization.*
- + *The lecturers working in the college should form a disciplined and purposeful team, subordinating their individual interests and caprices to the college academic purpose and fit into an harmonious organizational framework. They should help the Principal in maintaining discipline in the college.*
